

## WORDS OF LIFE AND HEALTH

Lord, I thank You that nothing failed of the good things You spoke to the house of Israel, but that all came to pass (Joshua 21:45). And praise God, we have a better covenant than they had. Praise God! The Lord is my Shepherd and I have no lack or need (Ps. 23:1).

Thank You Father, that when I cried unto You, You healed me (Ps. 30:2). And with long life You are satisfying me and showing me Your salvation. (Ps. 91:16).

For Your Words are life to me and they are health to all my flesh. I keep my heart with all diligence for out of it are the issues (success or failure) of life (Prov. 4:20-23).

Father, Your Word says that death & life are in the power of the tongue and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. So Father, I speak life with my tongue and therefore I eat the fruit of life (Prov. 18:21).

Lord, I thank You that without cause, the curse cannot come upon me and I will not open the door to the curse (Prov. 26:2b).

I thank You Father that as I wait upon You my strength shall be renewed; I shall mount up with wings as eagles; I shall run and not be weary; and I shall walk & not faint. Hallelujah! (Isaiah 40:31).

I thank You Lord that I am not weak, but I am strong in You and in the power of Your might (Joel 3:10; Eph. 6:10).

Praise God! Father I thank You that my body is full of the life and health of God. Every tissue, cell, organ, area, part and member of my body functions to the perfection to which You created it to function. My blood is healthy & normal in Jesus Name. My chemical balance is normal in Jesus Name and my bones are strong and healthy and normal in the Name of Jesus.

And Father because I do not forget Your Word and I keep Your commandments, Your Word is health (medicine) to my navel, and marrow (watering & moistening) to my bones (Prov. 3:8).

Jesus Himself took my infirmities and bare my sicknesses (Mt. 8:17). Who His own self bare my sins in His own body on the tree, that I being dead unto sins, do live unto righteousness; by whose stripes I was healed (I Peter 2:24).

Father, I thank You that because I have faith in You, I say to the mountain, be removed and be cast into the sea; and because I doubt not in my heart, but I believe those things I say, they shall come to pass and I shall have whatsoever I say. Therefore, when I pray, I believe I received them and I shall have them. (Mk. 11:22-24).

Father, I thank You that because I worship You and I do Your will, You hear me (Jn. 9:31).

Jesus said, "The thief came not but for to steal and to kill and destroy, but I came to give life and that you might have life more abundantly (Jn. 10:10).
